Duke of Edinburgh Award Training Courses

DofE has scheduled some free adult courses for National Operating Authorities in September and October which can be booked through DofE. These are virtual courses in two parts - leaders need to attend both parts.

Courses include:

- 'Introduction to the DofE' which is useful for new DofE leaders
- 'Expedition Assessor & Supervisor Training' - this is recommended for adults who are or will be supervising DofE expeditions and is mandatory to become a DofE expedition assessor

These are general DofE courses and do not include any specific Girlguiding information, but are relevant and useful for leaders supporting DofE through Girlguiding.

A specific Expedition Assessor & Supervisor Training course will be scheduled for October time (dates to be confirmed).
