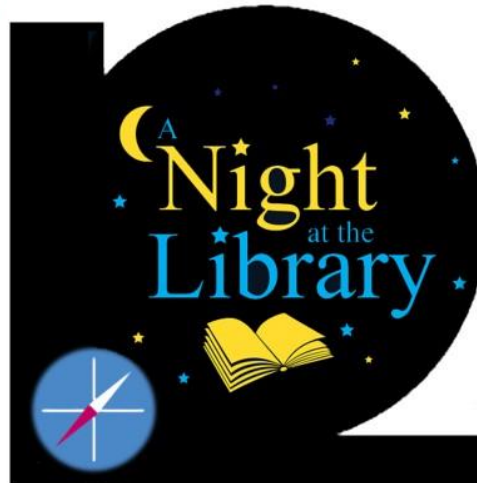

All Stars Cricket - Taster Sessions

Hampshire Cricket is offering our younger members an introduction to a Cricket taster session!

Hampshire Cricket Board are promoting All Stars Cricket, a national programme for 5-8 year old children, which provides children and their families a great introduction to cricket. All Stars takes place at cricket clubs throughout the county from May 2019 - more info <http://www.allstarscricket.co.uk>

Now in it's third year, they have over 60,000 children taking part in All Stars across the county. 22% of the participants are girls but they would like that number to rise significantly and need your help!

Where

They would like to visit groups and deliver a FREE taster session, giving the girls the opportunity to try all of the skills involved in cricket. Please note they need a small hall as a minimum space to deliver the session in. All their coaches are ECB Level 2 qualified as a minimum, hold first aid and DBS certificates.
