

# The County Standard Silver Award

## Purpose

The County Standard Silver Award will be awarded to recognise and acknowledge the significant contribution and commitment that any adult member who has reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday and over has made to ensure that girls experience good, girl-led, Guiding in their units on a weekly basis. They will have made <u>a significant</u> contribution to Guiding in their local area.

These procedures have been agreed to ensure that the awarding of the County Standard Silver Award is fair and equitable.

### Criteria

- 1. Applications must be made without the knowledge of the nominee and supported by a minimum of 2 letters of recommendation.
- 2. The award may be made to any member reaching the criteria who has reached her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday and is involved in Guiding irrespective of the appointment they hold.
- 3. The nominee will be involved in Unit Guiding and helping to run a good girlled Guiding Unit. They will also have been involved in Guiding events and activities in their local area encouraging our young members to meet new challenges.
- 4. Nominations may be made by any member of Girlguiding, but must be supported by the appropriate Division Commissioner or Chairman of the Awards Sub-Committee.
- 5. The Award is a brooch in the form of a metal County Standard with a silver bar. The brooch may be worn in or out of guide wear.
- 6. Applications will not normally be considered more than six months after completion of service is undertaken in Guiding.

### Procedures

#### How to Apply:

- 1. Completed applications should be returned to the Chairman of the Awards Committee, together with original copies of letters of support. Application forms are available on the County website.
- 2. Letters of support should provide:
  - a. How the nominee has fulfilled the <u>significant contribution and</u> <u>commitment</u> needed to be considered for this award.
  - b. <u>2</u> letters of support.

- c. The writer's appointment or status and be signed and dated.
- d. Typewritten wherever possible.
- e. Letters sent by email are acceptable.
- 3. Please mark envelopes 'Confidential'. Letters will be treated with strictest confidence.

### After the Awards Sub-Committee has met:

- 1 Following consideration of the Award application, the Chairman will inform the appropriate Division Commissioner of the decision of the Sub-Committee.
- 2 The Sub-Committee's decision will be final. However:
  - a. On the advice of the Sub-Committee, an application can be resubmitted.
  - b. A brand new application may be submitted for a nominee after a period of two years.
- 3 The Award will be presented, wherever possible, by the County Commissioner or her nominated representative on a suitable occasion.
