# Safe Space Training

There are four levels of training. All volunteers will need to do at least Level 1

The following trainings are available on-line

### A Safe Space, Level 1 - An introduction - On Line

For all volunteers including occasional helpers, GO coordinators, home contacts, peer educators and young leaders.

### A Safe Space, Level 2 - Creating a safe space - Online

For leaders, assistant leaders, unit helpers, leaders in training, young leaders, peer educators and those that are doing levels 3 and 4.

Additionally, we will offer a Safe Space Level 2 face-to-face training for leaders who would prefer this option or who find they are recommended to undertake a face-to-face training following the on-line process
